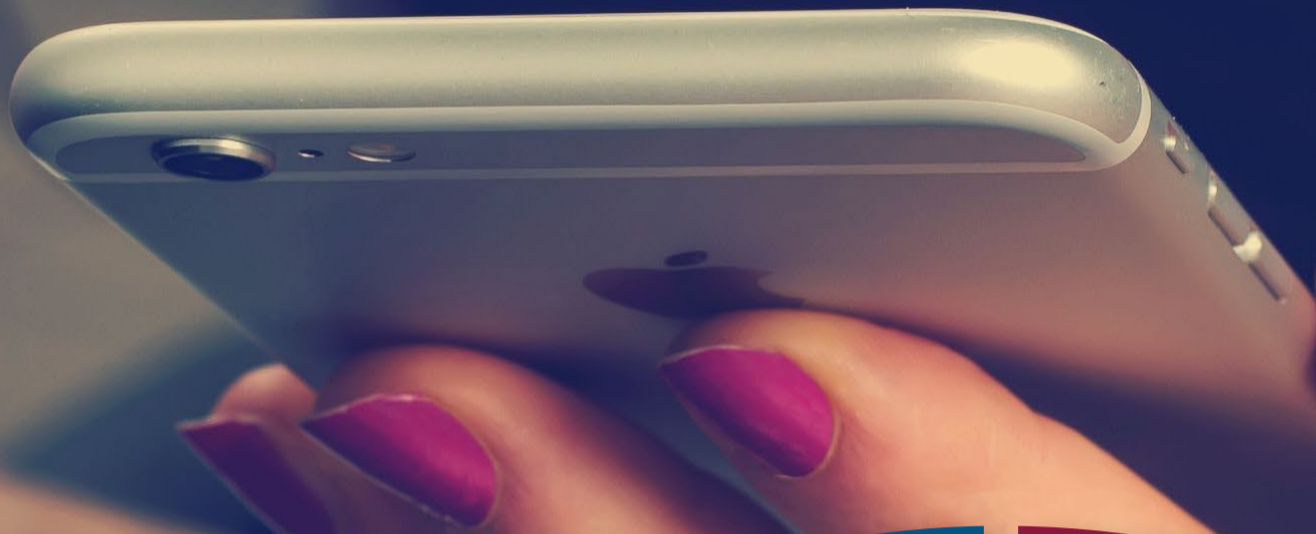

### THE LAW

### DATA THEFT

Data is at high vulnerability when workers are using mobile devices or storage media to share data, access company information, or neglect to scan for viruses and malware.

### LOCK IT

A worker who forgets to lock their phone, poses an enormous security threat to their employers' systems and data. This is as dangerous as a disgruntled user who maliciously leaks information to a competitor.

### CAMERA

In order to protect the privacy of the employer as well as of fellow employees, the use of cell phone cameras during working hours, on company premises is prohibited.

### ATTACKS

Internal attacks are one of the biggest threats to your data and systems. Rogue employees, members with access to networks, data centers and admin accounts, can cause serious damage.
